- Will have contributed financially while serving on the board and continued to support the Foundation after retiring from the Board. This could include financial, referral, expertise or other important opportunities as determined by the Staff of the Foundation.

Emeritus Trustees will be recommended by ACF staff based on the above criteria and approved by the Executive Committee or full Board of Trustees by Quarter 1 board meeting for publication in the annual report of the year of approval.
