

ACF staff recommend the following allocation of the 2022 Impact Funds.

Tapestry allocation	\$ 15,000	This is an important continuation of our Tapestry funding. This would be the fourth year of funding and it is important to staff to continue this important grantmaking
E2E Grant allocation	\$ 5,000	This is a contribution to the NM Funders Collaborative, which we lead. High impact collective grantmaking in education.
CEO Fund allocation	\$ 15,000	This provides an important resource to allow our CEO to make timely grants to the community based on his interactions with the community.
GGG	\$ 15,000	This is a critical funding source for the Great Grant Giveaway table grants.
Share NM	\$ 2,500	Staff recommend an additional year of funding Share after a long term commitment.
Education	\$ 15,000	This is a critical funding source for the community and is the least funded field of interest at the Foundation.
Strengthening Our Partners	\$ 40,226	Staff recommend allocating the remainder of Impact Funds to be used in strengthening our nonprofit partners, including nonprofit leadership development, opportunities for nonprofit grant writing workshops, development and growth for nonprofits as well as supporting coalition building in the nonprofit sector through funding, convening and relationship building.
