Sandia Foundation	Concentration on Albuquerque nonprofits that work with children in the community with regard to basic needs and advancing their education through long-term, consistent intervention and support.	\$358,000
Hammersley Foundation	Promotes charitable activities that expand the public's awareness, appreciation and understanding of Frederick Hammersley's art and life, promoting the value of art in life and the community. Supports the advancement of artists' education and creative processes, including support for research and scholarships for art students and other practitioners of the arts.	\$200,000

Arts & Culture	Organizations and programs that provide access to arts (visual or performing) and culture for the community	\$64,000
Education	Focus on supporting students to ensure they receive educational opportunities to enhance the course of their lives and careers i.e., elementary education literacy programs, students from underserved communities, youth from under-resourced communities, students with special needs and skills-based education for youth and adults.	\$53,000
Environmental & Historic Preservation	Working to preserve the environment and improve environmental conditions and/or working within the agricultural sector to bolster economic growth.	\$80,000
Health	Organizations meeting the mental health needs (including behavioral health and addiction recovery) and supporting dental health needs of individuals from early childhood-aged to seniors.	\$84,000
Human Services	Organizations that serve one or more of the following: parental or guardian skills training, teen pregnancy, job training, independent living and children aging out of foster care.	\$80,000

Regranting Programs

Organization	Description	Avg/yr
Childhood Tax Credit	The Childhood Tax Credit grant funding is intended to support nimble, grassroots nonprofits organizations to ensure that BIPOC, immigrant, low-income and other hard to reach populations can effectively access the Child Tax Credit program.	\$100,000
dEi United/Kellogg Grant Program	The Kellogg Grant Program is run collaboratively with United Way through the DEI United partnership and focuses on grassroots, BIPOC led organizations working to address systemic inequity. The grant program runs for two years, and outcomes include co-developing equitable grantmaking processes with the nonprofit recipients. Fiscal Sponsor is United Way. Total of \$2million over 2 years.	\$1 million
MacKenzie Scott Program	The Mackenzie Scott Grant Program is run collaboratively with United Way through the DEI United partnership. The fund provides unrestricted, large, multi-year grants to organizations working to address systemic inequities. Grants are focused to BIPOC led organizations, and/or organizations that are led by the communities they serve. Funds came from the Mackenzie Scott \$10 million grant to United Way. United Way has committed \$1 million to this purpose over the next five years. Fiscal Sponsor is United Way. Total of \$1million over 5 years.	\$200,000
Housing Stability	New Mexico Community Trust and ACF are administering a federal Housing Stability program on behalf of the State of New Mexico. The program is statewide and runs from 2022-2025. The total presented is the funding total throughout the program period. Additionally, the NMCT/ACF has a 10 – 15% gross administrative allocation for the program. Total of \$23.9 million over 4 years.	\$6 million

Organization	Description	Avg/yr
All Together New Mexico	The All Together NM Fund was established in 2020 by the New Mexico Coalition of Community Foundations in conjunction with the Governor's office to help New Mexico respond to and eventually recover from the COVID-19 pandemic. The Fund has now been reactivated to support wildfire relief and recovery in all counties that have been affected. Fiscal Sponsor is Santa Fe Community Foundation.	\$1.5 million
Emergency Action Fund	Provides funding for nonprofit organizations facing a crises or extreme challenge. The Fund was activated to support nonprofit organizations struggling with lost and non-recoverable revenue expenses due to the pandemic and is currently supporting wildfire relief and recovery in NM.	\$450,000
PNM Crisis Fund	To provide a source of relief to employees who are facing financial hardship due to their own immediate family member's catastrophic event, life threatening illness or injury, or the death of immediate family member.	\$50,000

Organization	Description	Avg/yr
Future Fund	Established by ACF BOT to encourage philanthropy among young, professionals. Future Fund has own committee to plan events i.e., membership drives as well as serve on grants committee.	\$30,000
Social Giving Club	The next level from the Future Fund, Social Giving Club strives to make significant impact on the lives of others who need a lift.	\$25,000
Maggie's Giving Circle	Maggie created a giving circle so her friends, who have like-minded interests in supporting the community, could collectively leverage their gifts to have a greater impact in helping to solve social issues; Members will work through a grant making process to select causes they care about to receive financial awards.	\$10,000
Cinco Amigos	Purpose is for grants exclusively for charitable, scientific, or educational objectives, including but not limited to issues concerning children and youth, and subject to the purpose and intent of the Foundation.	\$82,500
