Mr. Colón also led the largest recovery in the history of the New Mexico State Auditor's Office and obtained over \$13 million in funds for overcharges to seniors by insurance intermediaries.

A graduate of the Army War College National Security Seminar, Mr. Colón is also a former Honorary Commander of Kirtland Air Force Base. He is a past trustee for the Albuquerque Community Foundation and served on the New Mexico Hispanic Bar Association's (NMHBA) Board of Directors and the State Bar of New Mexico's Committee on Diversity. Mr. Colón has been twice appointed as a Commissioner for the New Mexico Judicial Selection Commission. He is currently back on the NMHBA Board of Directors and serves as Treasurer and Lifetime Member of the National Association of Latino Elected Officials (NALEO).
